Drilling Additional Mounting Holes in Drive

- 1) Remove factory cover from back of Bravo drive. Clean drive face and o-ring groove to remove any foreign material.
- 2) Mount stainless steel drive cap to drive, using new drive seal, studs and nuts supplied with drive cap.
- 3) Insert drill bushing into two (2) additional holes below bottom ear on drive cap.
- 4) Using an "F" drill (.257) drill into drive 1.25" deep.
- 5) Remove drill bushings and tap holes with a 5/16-18RH tap.

NOTE: A bottom tap should be used finally to ensure maximum amount of threads to bottom of hole.

6) After tapping both holes, blow any debris out of holes making sure holes are clean. A light thread locking compound is recommended on the two (2) 5/16" bolts before installing. Tighten bolts.
